### Eligibility:

Applicant schools must be a graduate of the Mid Michigan Waste Authority 4REE Program, and continue regularly collecting paper from classrooms for recycling (no weighing required) throughout the enrolled **4R 4Ever** school year.

### 4R 4Ever Program Requirements:

To earn a **4R 4Ever** school designation, participating schools must successfully complete a minimum of three (3) of the **4R 4Ever** program activities. Participating schools must send in a completed **4R 4Ever** certification form (attached), noting which activities were implemented and providing a written description detailing how the school fulfilled each of the chosen **4R 4Ever** activities. Also include the number of student participants, date completed/held and duration of each chosen activity. Where possible, please enclose pictures of activities for review and use by MMWA.

### How to Apply / Deadlines:

Interested schools should fill out the above application information and indicate the activities they plan to implement from the attached program activity list. Mail the application back to MMWA to register the school in **4R 4Ever**. All **4R 4Ever** applications must be signed and dated by the school administrator/principal. The application deadline is **October 15**.

Schools have until **May 15** of the participating school year to complete the chosen activities and file the **4R 4Ever** certification form with MMWA. Schools successfully completing all selected program requirements are eligible for 4R- themed books and other interesting 4R/recycling awards, plus a certificate of completion.

Certification of successful completion of the **4R 4Ever** program will be made by **June 1** of each school year. If interested, schools can request a formal presentation of their **4R 4Ever** certificate from MMWA.
