

Cereal Box Picture Frame

Items you will need to make a picture frame:

- boxboard, such as an empty cereal box
- colorful magazine pages
- glue or adhesive
- double-sided tape
- a pencil, dowel, or chopstick
- an easel (created from side panel and bottom flap of cereal box, as shown below)



Instructions:

- Cut two pieces of boxboard from the empty cereal box that are approximately 1 inch larger than your photo. For a 4" x 6" photo, cut your cereal box about 5" x 7",
- Take one piece of boxboard and cut an opening approximately 3.5" x 5.5" in the center to frame the photo (see above).
- Attach the two pieces of boxboard together. Using double-sided tape, tape only along the bottom edge and the two sides, leaving the top edge open to slide the photo inside.
- Tightly roll the colorful magazine pages on a pencil. Smear a small amount of glue to secure the edge and to prevent it from unrolling. Once the rolled pieces are dry, cut them to fit the frame in an artistic arrangement.
- Glue the rolled pieces to the cereal box frame placing them tightly side-by-side. Let dry.
- Bend the side panel of the cereal box where it meets the bottom flap. Glue the bottom flap to the back of the frame, and the side panel will create an easel (as shown at right). Insert your favorite photo of a friend, loved one, or even a pet!
