What to bring:

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

including motor oil, gasoline, antifreeze, mercury, kerosene, acids, aerosols, fluorescent bulbs, lawn/garden chemicals, lead acid batteries, smoke detectors, glues & adhesives, hobby chemicals, misc. cleaners and corrosives

ELECTRONICS

including televisions, computers, hard drives, laptops, keyboards, printers, mice, fax machines, phones, scanners, tablets, monitors, and misc. cables and cords

PAINT

including spray paint, latex paint, oil-based paint, caulk, stain, and varnish

Eyeglasses and eyeglass cases

DOCUMENT SHREDDING DAY

Thursday, September 17 2 pm to 6 pm

What to bring:

Up to two boxes of paper documents per person for confidential on-site shredding

MMWA is no longer a Polystyrene Foam drop off site

NOTE:

This year there are no separate days for paint, electronics and hazardous waste. All items (except documents to be shredded) should be brought to the All-in-One Days.

HOUSEHOLD Special Waste Program Rules:

Proof of Residency required No farms, schools or businesses No containers over 5 gallons Containers will not be returned

Do NOT bring:

CRT tubes removed from televisions Explosives or ammunition Tires

Asbestos

Electronics that are not TV or computer related

SAFE TRANSPORTATION TIPS

Do not mix different chemicals!

Leave substances in their original containers, and make sure caps and/or lids are securely closed. Place containers in sturdy boxes in an upright position.

Never transport leaking or open containers.

IMPORTANT:

When you make your appointment, please let us know if you have unknown or unlabeled chemicals. Safety is a priority!
