Answers to submitted questions:

1. Could you provide current rates for the different services being done in 2022?

See Attachment A for pricing charts from MMWA's current collection services agreement.

See Attachment B for pricing chart from MMWA's landfill agreement.

2. Paraphrased question regarding increased landfill tonnage in 2021 and 2022 and its corresponding impact on the five year average provided in the RFP.

See Attachment C for 10 year history of solid waste tonnage, recycling tonnage and yard waste cubic yards.

3. Would the MMWA be willing to push the due date back 2 weeks to February 21, 2022? With the significance in size and detail for this RFP, those 2 additional weeks will be vitally important in evaluating the service territory to allow us to provide our most thorough proposal.

4. Page 1: What time is the pre-proposal meeting? It is not listed.

9:30 AM

5. Page 4, Delivery: Bids are due February 7, 2022 at 12pm. Will there be a public opening immediately after the 12pm deadline?

The time for the delivery of Bids has been changed to 2:00 pm on Monday, February 7, 2022. Bids should now be delivered to the Thomas Twp Public Safety Building conference room. Bids will be opened beginning at 2:05 pm.

6. Page 10, h: Professional liability insurance is coverage we cannot be insured for since we are not a professional service. Can this be removed from the insurance requirements?

7. Page 11, #9 Laws and Ordinances: Are there any unique laws, rules and regulations for Saginaw and Gratiot Counties you can share with us?

No.

8. Page 14, #21 Termination: Is termination limited to "with cause" or is this a termination for "convenience" clause?

With cause as determined by Mid Michigan Waste Authority.

9. Page 15, Is there a requirement for disposal/processing facility for trash, recycling, and/or compost or is it up to the contractor's discretion?

See DISPOSAL SITES beginning on page 30 and Attachment H.

10. Page 18, Residential Bulk Waste/White Goods Waste: is Freon removal from applicable appliances the responsibility of the homeowner or the contractor?

The Contractor.

11. Page 19, Recycling, Suitable Recyclables Containers: The RFP mentions a 50% revenue sharing agreement as part of the RFP. Is this currently in place? If so, can you provide documentation on this agreement and invoices showing the revenue sharing?

MMWA does not currently have a revenue sharing agreement in place.

12. Page 22, Side Door Service: How many households currently participate in "side door service"?

Approximately 30 households.

13. Page 23, Office Space: please clarify what is meant by "providing office space". Is the contractor providing office space with MMWA employees?

The contractor would be providing an independent space for MMWA's administrative offices. MMWA currently occupies independent office space provided as part of its landfill extension agreement with Waste Management. MMWA is seeking the same or similar independent space or a subsidy equal to the cost of MMWA establishing such independent office space for the duration of the agreement.

14. Page 28, 7th paragraph: It mentions that Saturday and Sunday cannot be used as a designated collection day. Please confirm this excludes weeks where a Holiday affects the normal service.

The collection Contractor will be required to follow a holiday collection schedule that provides material collection one day later for the remainder of the week for those designated holidays that fall on a week day. Designated holidays that fall on a weekend day will not delay collection services. Any changes to the observed holiday schedule must be agreed upon by both parties.

15. Page 30, Performance Guarantees: Is there only 1 performance bond for the entire service which covers the 34 municipalities or are there individual performance bonds for each individual municipality?

The performance bond is for the contract. The contract encompasses service for each member community.

16. Page 32, Carts: This section mentions labelling which would be MMWA specific. Will these remain property of the contractor upon completion of the service agreement or will they be property of the homeowners inside the MMWA communities?

Bidder is responsible for removing all carts at the conclusion of the contract.

17. Page 33, second paragraph: It mentions a requirement for "carts manufactured in Michigan that contain at minimum 10% PCCR" or "30% postindustrial recycle material." Does the MMWA have a container company they are familiar with that aligns with these requirements?

Cascade.

All other bidding terms, requirements and conditions continue as indicated in the remaining original bid document.

In the submission of their Bid, Bidder must acknowledge receipt of this addendum. Bidder shall acknowledge this addendum by signing and returning one copy of this notice with their submission.
